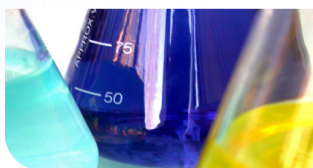


CLP Regulation Services

Classification, Labelling, and Packaging



The Challenge

The European Union CLP Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008 was enacted to protect workers, consumers and the environment from hazardous chemicals. The CLP Regulation requires manufacturers, importers, and downstream users to classify, label, and package substances and mixtures within scope before placing them on the market.

In order to maintain access to the EU market, companies need to notify the classification of substances sold *both individually and in mixtures*. The Notification must be generated using specific IT Tools and it must be submitted to ECHA within 30 days after manufacture or import into the EU.
