Intertek Warns of ETL Certification Mark on Recalled Surge Protectors

Published: September 22, 2016- Updated May 16, 2019

The following is a safety notification from Intertek that the Surge Protectors identified below bears Intertek Certification Marks for the United States and Canada.

See CPSC Recall number: 16-193 here.

Product Description	This recall involves three models of surge protectors, Idealist (360320), Idealist 2.4 (360321) and Agent (360322). The model number is located on the underside of the unit. The units have seven outlets, come in black or white and measure 14.5 inches long by 2.5 inches wide by 1.5 inches tall. "360electrical" is printed on the front of the units. Recalled surge protectors do not have a single check mark engraved on the underside of the unit, right next to the model number.
Manufacturer	360 Electrical
Number of Units	About 9,300 (in addition, about 1,000 were sold in Canada)
Identification	On Product: The product bears a direct imprint of model numbers with the cETLus certification mark, but without an adjacent control number.
Reported Hazards	The surge protectors can short circuit when non-grounded plugs are connected, posing a shock or fire hazard.
Sold at	B&H Photo stores nationwide and online at Amazon.com and bhphotovideo.com from July 2015 through February 2016 for between \$33 and \$40.
