Intertek Warns of Hazardous Digital Clamp Meters Bearing an ETL Certification Mark

The following is a notification from Intertek that the Extech digital clamp meters identified below bearing Intertek Certification Marks for the United States and Canada have been determined to pose a public hazard.

Product Description	<i>This recall involves Extech digital clamp meters with model numbers EX650, EX655, MA160, MA61, and MA63. These models are all AC/DC clamp meters, which are electrical testing devices that measure AC/DC voltage, resistance, capacitance, frequency, temperature, continuity, and diode. Serial numbers in the following format are included in the recall: R15XXXXXXXX to R17XXXXXXXX. Only serial numbers in this range are included in the recall. The "EXTECH" logo and the model number are printed on the front of the unit and the serial number on the back. The digital clamp meters are green and orange</i>
