		In accordance with 8.5.6, a multioutlet assembly provided with hospital grade receptacles shall be marked where visible during installation with the word "WARNING" and the following or the equivalent: "Do Not Use this Multioutlet Assembly in General Patient Care Areas or Critical Patient Care Areas. It has not been evaluated for installation in accordance with the requirements of Article 517 of the National Electrical Code, ANSI/NFPA 70." The marking shall be a tearresistant flag label permanently affixed to the assembly. The background shall be Safety Orange and the verbiage shall be in Black in accordance with ANSI Safety

Color Code Z535.1 and Product Safety Signs and Labels Z535.4.
