The United States Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act requires publicly traded companies to trace and audit their supply chains in order to ensure their products are not financing conflict through sourcing of Tin, Tantalum, Tungsten and/or Gold from mines in the Democratic Republic of Congo or surrounding countries. With this, the SEC is leading efforts to move supply to conflict-free sources.
