EFFECTIVE DATE OF NEW/REVISED REQUIREMENTS

Effective Date: **December 3, 2021**

IMPACT, OVERVIEW, AND ACTION REQUIRED

Impact Statement: A review of all Listing Reports is necessary to determine which products comply with new/revise requirements and which products will require re-evaluation.

Overview of Changes:

- December 3, 2021 is the effective date. New and revised products submitted for certification on and after the effective date will be required to be investigated to CAN/ULC 60839-11-1. All new and revised products that would have been previously certified to CAN/ULC S319, will then be investigated to CAN/ULC 60839-11-1.
- Existing certifications of these products will be allowed to continue to be certified after December 3, 2021 and not be withdrawn provided there are no changes to the physical equipment design or function or until a new/revise requirement in Standard CAN/ULC 60839-11-1 is determined as "Action Required" to require a review in the future. For example, if there are changes to the physical equipment design or function after the effective date, the product (in its entirety) will need to be evaluated to CAN/ULC 60839-11-1.
