As part of the preparation of the Ministerial Diploma updating the list of products subject to the Conformity Assessment Programme (CAP) prior to their import into Mozambique, under Decree no. 8/2022 of 14 March and taking into account the need to continue socialisation activities with the private sector, INNOQ, IP hereby informs INTERTEK that during this period of technical work and until the publication of the aforementioned Ministerial Diploma, the following products should not be subject to the CAP

- 1- In special customs regimes;
- 2- Alcoholic drinks and tobacco;
- 3- Raw materials, machinery and spare parts for industrial and agricultural use:
- 4- Machinery, equipment and industrial spare parts imported by manufacturers for their own use;
- 5- Equipment and parts from medical equipment manufacturers;
- 6- Goods imported for on-board services in aircraft, boats or ships and in mining activities;
- 7 Printed material and recorded digital media;
