ENFORCEMENT DATE	All Phase I Regulated Product Shipments arriving in Mozambique with an Importer's UCR number or Bil Lading (BL) or Air Waybill (AWB) or Road Manifest or Letter of Credit (LC) dated 1 st November onwards subject to mandatory certification.

MINIMUM THRESHOLD VALUE	Shipments with a declared Free On Board (FOB) value of less than USD 2,000.00 are exempted from the Mozambique CAP, except for used products.

STEP 1 - APPLICATION REVIEW:

The Exporter must submit their enquiry to the nearest Intertek Office in their geographical region and on confirmation of the regulatory status of their shipment provide the following qualifying documents:

- Completed Request for Certification (RFC)
- Mozambique Unique Consignment Reference (UCR) number
- Proforma Invoice, Purchase Order, Letter of Credit, Packing List, Final Invoice
- Mozambican tariff code(s) for each of the product(s) listed in the Proforma/Final Invoice
- Product specifications or datasheet
- Valid Test reports/Test Certificates (if available)

STEP 2 - DOCUMENT EVALUATION:

An assessment of the submitted documents will be carried out by Intertek to verify the compliance of the Regulated Product Shipment to the applicable Mozambican Standards or in its absence to other relevant Regional/International Standards.

At this stage, based on the Exporter's frequency and volume of shipments, the Exporter will be advised about the different Shipment Certification Routes (Route A, B and C) available to them and recommend to them the Registration and Licensing options which are explained in detail in the subsequent sheet.

STEP 3 - INSPECTION:

Subject to the certification Route, physical inspection of the Regulated Product Shipments shall be carried out by Intertek. The inspection process will include verification of the product(s) essential markings and physical requirements as per the applicable Mozambican Standards or in its absence to other relevant Regional/International Standards.

- Route A: Mandatory Physical Inspection shall be carried out for every shipment.
- Route B: Selective Physical Inspection shall be carried out for at least one shipment every three (3)
 months.
- Route C: Selective Physical Inspection shall be carried out for at least one shipment every 6 months.
- Route D: Mandatory Physical Inspection shall be carried out for every shipment at destination.

STEP 4 - TESTING:

- In absence of valid test reports, Intertek will draw samples from the shipment during the inspection stage for testing purposes.
- These samples would need to be tested in an ISO/IEC 17025 accredited laboratory according to the applicable Mozambican Standards or in its absence to other relevant Regional/International Standards.

STEP 5 - CONTAINER LOADING AND SEALING:

Mandatory witnessing of loading of FCL (Full Container Load) shipments and its subsequent Sealing.

STEP 6 – CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMITY (CoC) ISSUANCE:

 A CoC will be issued based on successful conformity assessment of the shipment. Non-conforming shipments will be issued with a Non-Conformity Report (NCR).

REGISTRATION

- Registration is a verification process performed by Intertek before the Regulated Products are shipped.
- The Registration of products shall be based on a detailed evaluation of the product's conformity to applicable Mozambican Standards or in its absence to other relevant Regional/International standards.
- The Registered products and Registration are valid for a period of one (1) year.

LICENSING

- Licensing is a verification process performed by Intertek before the Regulated Products are shipped.
- The Licensing of Regulated Products shall be based on a detailed evaluation of the product's conformity to applicable Mozambican Standards or in its absence to other relevant Regional/International Standards and Factory Audit.
- The Licence is valid for a period of one (1) year.

ROUTE A – Applicable for Non-registered/ Non-licensed Products

- This Route is recommended for Traders/Exporters who have low export frequency and low volume of Regulated Product Shipments to Mozambique.
- The Unregistered/Unlicensed products under this Route would need evidence of testing for every Regulated Product Shipments.

ROUTE B - Applicable for Registered Products

- This Route is recommended for Exporters who have a high frequency and high volume of Regulated Product Shipments to Mozambique.
- Route B offers a faster shipment certification process for products with reasonable and consistent levels of quality and safety through product registration prior to their export.

ROUTE C - Applicable for Licensed Products

CERTIFICATION ROUTES

- Route C is recommended for Manufacturers/Authorized distributors who have a high frequency and high volume of Regulated Product Shipments to Mozambique.
- Route C offers a faster shipment certification process on account of reduced inspection/testing intervention.

ROUTE D – Destination Verification

- Route D is an option available for those Exporters who have missed obtaining a CoC from Intertek, for their Regulated Product Shipments in the Country of Supply/Export.
- The Non-registered/ Non-licensed Regulated Product Shipments under this Route would undergo conformity assessment by Intertek at destination.
- Regulated Product shipments arriving at Mozambican Ports/Borders without a CoC will be subjected to a higher CAP fee payable by the Importer and will face delays in Customs clearance.

- The above-mentioned fees cover the documentary verification and inspection of Regulated Product Shipments.
- The above fees exclude laboratory testing, Registration and Licensing of products. The fees quoted above are exclusive of Sales Tax and Value Added Tax.
- Shipments with a declared FOB value of less than USD 2,000 are exempted from the Mozambique CAP, except for Used Regulated Product Shipments.

Registration and Licensing Fees:

- The Registration and Licensing fees are subject to the type of product being Registered or Licensed.
 Exporters need to contact their local Intertek office for a quotation.
- The Registration and Licensing fees do not include laboratory testing and Factory Audit fees.
